Luke 11:1-4 - The Lord's Prayer

Jesus teaches his disciples how to pray, and Luke describes his version of the Lord's Prayer. Notice the order in this prayer. First Jesus praised God; then he made his requests. Next, the Lord explained that God's provision is daily, not all at once. "Daily" also means that you are trusting God to give you what you need today and tomorrow. Finally, Jesus made forgiveness the foundation for having a relationship with God. He has forgiven our sins, and now we must forgive those who have wronged us. Think of people who have hurt you. Have you forgiven them? How will God deal with you If he treats you as you treat others?
