

Some quick facts about the trip...

We had 28 students in our group from the Diocese of Fort Worth, including 5 students from SEAS. There were also 13 adults, including two seminarians and one of the CFR's. Bishop Vann marched with us and also lead night prayer for our group in the crypt church of the National Basilica after the vigil Mass on Sunday night. He also con-celebrated the vigil Mass along with 5 cardinals including Cardinal DiNardo, 45 bishops, about 300 priests and hundreds of deacons and acolytes. The basilica was completely full as it is every year with about 10,000 people. There were about 400,000 at the March itself on Monday. We visited the offices of both our Senators and spoke to their health staffers and also visited with a couple of our Congressmen to encourage them to continue to support the Pro-Life postions. It was a great experience for the youth as well as all of us who went. I'd love to see more of our Knights attend with us next year.
