year. Recently, I have been out of town a lot, on our parish mission to Guatemala, and also for my annual retreat. I made my retreat up in Oklahoma, at Clear Creek Benedictine Monastery. It was great to get out of the city and enjoy the quiet of the secluded monastery. I had the chance to read and pray a lot, and also to work with the monks in their garden. It is good for the soul to work in the dirt every now and then.

Otherwise, I MC'ed the Rite of Election at St. Francis parish as well as at St. Joseph. For our catechumens, this is the last step before their initiation at Easter Vigil. I had never seen one of these liturgies before, so I was glad to have experienced it. Here at St. Joseph's, I have been working with the music director to introduce more chant into our Sunday liturgies. So far, the response has been very positive, and we even have people coming up to us and asking to join the choir. I'm also continuing to work on the pipe organ campaign. Once the pipe organ is installed in about three years, the music here will be incredible.
