Another Spring Break and another retreat for me. I hope things have been well for you and Valerie. I just thought I'd drop a line to let you (and all the Brother Knights of the Council, if you could tell them) know that I'll be going to the Burgundy region of France for 'monastery hopping' in this next week. Thanks to Fordham, there has been a class on Monasticism this semester, and it includes a trip to Paris and a few monasteries in France. The monasteries include Cluny, the Carmel de la Paix in Mazille, and the former Cistercian Abbey of Fontenay, and Vezelay Abbey. The trip concludes with a stay at Taize. Though I've never been to Europe, or even the Eastern Hemisphere before (nor too

much of a desire), I feel France is a good place to start, during Lent no less, and I'll be close to the shrine of St. John Vianney!

Though there has been the educational aspect in this class, I plan to consider the trip as one major retreat, and just wanted to let you know that you and your family will be in my prayers during this next week. I've often considered this class and trip a continuation of those retreats we took down to Laredo (often during Spring Break and the season Lent!), and your awesome cooking. There is also the art historical aspect, taught from a great man at Fossil Ridge, and of course Fordham has provided the theological considerations. This course came together nicely. We do a shotgun start at 5:30 p.m. We play at Sky Creek Ranch in Keller (\$25.00 plus tax) on the second Thursday of the month, and we play Champions Circle GC in north Fort Worth across 114 from the Texas Motor Speedway (\$20.00 plus tax) on the fourth Thursday of the month. This is an informal league; we don't turn in scorecards, and you need not be present each time we play. I collect \$2.00 per player before play begins for the closest to the pin on one of the par 3's. Winner buys the first round or couple of pitchers after golf!
