It has been brought to our attention that this group has been involved activities that go against our prayerful mission. The Fort Worth Diocese Respect Life office has issued a letter from the attorney of the Citizens United for Life (CUL) that strongly urges their prayer staff and sidewalk counselors to not

go to the facility when this group is active, as any illegal or uncharitable actions that this group does, may reflect upon CUL merely by association. This severely causes me concern since high school youth attend the vigils with us.

Therefore, I am moving the prayer vigil back to the Planned Parenthood on John Ryan Road. The Planned Parenthood does not perform abortions at this times, and is not always open, however, our presence with show the community that something is going here that is not right. This Planned Parenthood does refer women to Dallas for their abortions.

We will still meet at the Pius XII Center (PCC) at 8am and drive to the Planned Parenthood.
