Subject: Membership Dues Recap for 2011

Brother Knights of Council 759,

We are 3 months into the calandar year of 2011.

This is just a quick overview of the membership and dues for the Council. ALI of you should be aware of the \$60.00 dues assessment breakdown. As a reminder \$53.00 of the \$60.00 is for Supreme, State and Local association assessments.

That leaves \$7.00 for the Council to support itself. The Council relies heavily on your participation in its Charity works.

The Council has 545 members on its official Roll. Of that 422 members has met their obligation to pay their dues. 123 members have not. This leaves the Council a shortfall of

\$8735.00 that must be made up somewhere.

Thanks goes out to the 422 members who have met their obligation to support the Council. Charity does being at your home Council.

If you have not met your 2011 dues obligation please do so as soon as possible. If you are unable due to financial or physical issues the Grand Knight and Financial Secretary will make allowances. All you need to do is let one of them know.

If you have not been to the Council Meeting Hall lately there have been numerous changes due to the generosity of some members. Soon the patio enclosure will be completed, This will be followed by a 6ft picket fence in the rear of the property. If you are able to assist financially that would be greatly appreciated. Contact the Hall Committee Chairman or Grand Knight.

The Hall is available to use at a very minimal fee to Hall Members. If you are not a member, see the Hall Manager or Hall Committee Chairman.

We did this event 5 years ago. Those that went will tell you it was a great time and Murco was very appreciative and generous in their donation for our efforts .

SEAS Golf League Information 2011

The SEAS Golf League plays nine holes on the second and fourth Thursday evenings of the month, from the end of March through September. We do a shotgun start at 5:30 p.m. We play at Sky Creek Ranch in Keller (\$25.00 plus tax) on the second Thursday of the month, and we play Champions Circle GC in north Fort Worth across 114 from the Texas Motor Speedway (\$20.00 plus tax) on the fourth Thursday of the month. This is an informal league; we don't turn in scorecards, and you need not be present each time we play. I collect \$2.00 per player before play begins for the closest to the pin on one of the par 3's. Winner buys the first round or couple of pitchers after golf!

Sign up for each league night the week before by responding to my e-mail to the group whether or not you are "in" for the next league night. We have been asked by the courses we play to please play only nine holes on league night, per our contract.
