The Holy Spirit

The New Testament details a close relationship between the Holy Spirit and Jesus during his earthly life and ministry. The Gospels of Luke and Matthew state that Jesus was "conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary." The Holy Spirit descended on Jesus as a dove during his Baptism, and in his Farewell Discourse after the Last Supper Jesus promised to send the Holy Spirit to his disciples after his departure.

The Holy Spirit is frequently referred to by metaphors and symbols such as water in Baptism, anointing with oil, fire in the form of tongues, cloud and light as in a voice on the mountain of transfiguration, a dove after

Jesus came up from the water of his Baptism, and the wind as a rush of sound from heaven.

In closing is a prayer entitled "Ablaze with the Fire of the Holy Spirit" O Lord, have mercy on us all,

take away from us our sins,

and mercifully set us ablaze with the fire of Your Holy Spirit

Take away from us the heart of stone, and give us a human heart, a heart to love and adore You. Amen
