Mary, Mother of Christ, Mother of the Church

Since the Virgin Mary's role in the mystery of Christ and the Spirit has been treated, it is fitting to consider her place in the mystery of the Church. The Virgin Mary is acknowledged and honored as being truly the Mother of God and of the redeemer. She is clearly the "mother" of the members of Christ, since she has by her charity, joined in bringing about the birth of believers in the Church. Mary's role in the Church is inseparable from her union with Christ and flows directly from it. This union of the mother with the Son, in the work of salvation is made manifest from the time of Christ's virginal conception up to his death. It is made manifest above all, at the hour of his Passion.

The Blessed Virgin advanced in her pilgrimage of faith, and faithfully persevered in her union with her Son unto the cross. There she stood, in keeping with the divine plan, enduring with her only begotten Son, the intensity of his suffering, joining herself with his sacrifice. After her Son's Ascension, Mary aided the beginnings of the Church by her prayers. In her association with the apostles, we see Mother Mary, imploring the gift of the Holy Spirit.

When the course of her earthly life was finished, the Immaculate Virgin Mary was preserved free from all stain of original sin, and taken up body and soul into heavenly glory, and exalted by the Lord, as Queen over all things, so that she would be fully conformed to her Son, the Lord of lords and conqueror of sin and death. From the earliest centuries of the Church, this gift of a mother has been reflected upon in some of the most beautiful writings in the Christian tradition. Jesus gave us His Mother. The Church is fundamentally a relational reality. Through Baptism, we now live our lives in the Lord by living in His Body, the Church, through which he continues his redemptive mission.

O Mary, Mother of God, You conceived the living God, and by your intercession of prayers, will deliver our souls from death. Amen.
