SPECIAL OLYMPICS SPRING GAMES

Statement:

Opening Ceremonies will be held from 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. at the UTA Maverick Stadium on Friday, May 22, 2015. The evening will begin with the entry of the law enforcement officers, followed by the Parade of Athletes.
