PH4 is a multi-denominational center that embraces the support for St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Church and notifies our parish's Respect Life committee was a Catholic is in need of help. PH4 underwent a rigorous interview process before our parish's Respect Life committee and Council 759 endorsed her four years ago. Therefore, several of our parishioners volunteer there and our junior and high school religious education programs conduct fund raisers and diaper drives for them.

Loreto House and Mothers and Unborn Baby Care are Catholic centers and you know this from the first step into the facilities. These are loving and merciful centers manned by a caring and supportive staff. Father Kyle Waltersheid is the spiritual director for Loreto House, while Bishop Olson is heavily involved with Mothers and Unborn Baby Care. Both centers have cared for thousands of women and babies through the years. The two centers are supported by many parishes and Knights of Columbus councils, however, they are always in need of volunteers, baby items and of course cash.

Like all other pregnancy resource centers in Texas, they do not do not get state or federal aid. They are supported solely through private donations. So, please consider supporting one the these centers as a volunteer or private donor.
