# **Sunday's Reading**

**Brothers:** 

The Nativity of Saint John the Baptist - Sunday, June 24

When this Solemnity of St. John the Baptist falls on a Sunday, it takes precedence over the Sunday in Ordinary Time. Immediately we should recognize that this feast is very important for the Church and for us.

John was the son of Zechariah and Elizabeth, and was six months older that his cousin Jesus. He was the last and greatest of the prophets, and prepared the way for the coming of Christ.

The Apostles considered John to be a kind of reincarnated Elijah, but his message was one of baptism and repentance, Many people mistook John for the Messiah, however, he always made it clear that someone stronger was coming after him to baptize with fire and the Holy Spirit.

One of John's greatest statements about Jesus was "He must increase, while I must decrease."
