PRO-LIFE BUS TRIP TO AUSTIN AUGUST 4TH

Brothers,

Last year through the efforts of the Pro-Life Community and the Texas Legislature, landmark legislation was passed to protect the health of women by compelling the abortion industry to act in a manner which meets current standards for a surgical facility.

On Monday August 4th, the Fifth Circuit Court will be hearing a suit filed by Whole Woman's Health. It attempts to strike key aspects of that legislation and would allow the centers in Texas to remain open after Sept. 1.

We need your help.

Several Pro-Life groups from all over Texas are preparing a prayer vigil in Austin to influence the judges to uphold the law.

The Diocese of Fort Worth will be represented in Austin.

You have the option of forming carpools yourself. Or we are going to try to organize bus transportation from Fort Worth to Austin and return.

There are several options depending on who is committed to go. Renting a bus will require at least 40 committed riders.

It will be on a first come, first served basis and will cost approximately \$35.00.

We have to be there by 8:00 AM which mandates a very early departure of 4:00 AM from Fort Worth. Departure location will be determined by committed riders. At this time I am suggesting the Catholic Charities location in south Fort Worth. Fraternally, Sean

2014 KC STATE OF TEXAS OPEN GOLF CHAMPIONSHIP

40th Annual Johnny Lopez 2014 Knights of Columbus State of Texas Open Golf Championships

2014 Tournament Information:

The 40th Annual Johnny Lopez Knights of Columbus State of Texas Open Golf Championship is being hosted by the Texas State Council and the Bastrop Knights of Columbus Council #14943. The tournament will be held the weekend of September 19, 20 & 21, 2014 at two different golf courses, Pine Forest Golf Club and ColoVista Golf Club. We did play Pine Forest Golf Club back in 2008 which is the last time the tournament was in Bastrop, Texas.

Pine Forest Golf Club will also host the Friday scramble tournament, which has a 1:00pm shotgun start. The Saturday and Sunday individual tournament play will be played at both the Pine Forest Golf Club and the ColoVista Golf Club, with an 8:00 AM., shotgun start both mornings. With an 8:00am shotgun start golfers are asked to be at their assigned golf course no later than 7:30am, so we can start our pretournament prayer and announcements.

Registration for the Friday Scramble and the Saturday/Sunday Individual Tournament will be held at Pine Forest Golf Club starting at 9:30am Friday morning and continuing until 5:30pm Friday evening. Late registration will be held at both golf courses on Saturday morning 6:30 to 7:30am.

Attached you will find a copy of the tournament entry form. Be sure to complete all the information requested, including council; flight; division; e-mail and membership numbers. Incomplete forms will delay your entry. For those of you who may have not ever played or have not played in one of K of C State Golf Tournaments within the past five (5) years, to establish a handicap for our tournament you will need to submit a copy of your club handicap card or two score cards from two separate rounds of golf on a 18hole golf course. For those of you who have played within the past five years we will have a handicap on record for you.

The entry fee for the scramble is \$70.00 per golfer and the entry fee for the individual two day tournament is \$130.00 per golfer, and if you sign up to play all three days your entry fee will be \$165.00. Your entry fee must accompany the registration form. Please make checks payable to: 'K of C State Athletic Fund''.

Unfortunately the tournament is limited to the first 220 paid golfers. Please pass along the word! Hotel/Motel information will accompany your golf confirmation letter.
