OFFICIAL PUBLIC NOTICE:

The KC Hall has \$5,000 approved in this year's budget for capital improvements. The Hall Committee is sponsoring a back porch project that has been in the making for five years. A back porch cover will be constructed to cover the back of the KC Hall. The total cost of the project is \$8,000. Therefore, it is necessary to bring to the membership for their approval a request to increase the budget by an additional \$3,000. The request was approved at the officer's meeting August 19th and the request will be read at the monthly business meeting September 2nd. After the reading of the request and appropriate discussion, at the business meeting, the request will be tabled. A special business meeting has been call by Grand Knight Jim Dowling for September 22nd at 7:00PM at the KC Hall for a final approval vote by the membership. The reason for the accelerated schedule of the project is to get it completed for Fall Fest.
