Brother Knights in Christ:

This Sunday's Gospel from Luke (LK 18:9-14) continues its reflection on prayer. Prayers of petition are usually the easiest to pray. We often say that prayer doesn't change God; rather it changes us. Our gospel story is the parable of two men who went to the temple to pray. One was filled with his own self-righteousness; the other humbly acknowledges his need.

This parable helps us to see where we must first begin: with a change of heart. Coming before the Lord with our need, our sinfulness, our openness to God must be the starting point for our prayer. Since all prayer is first the work of the holy Spirit in us, we can see how beginning our prayers in humility is already God working to change our hearts.

Come, let us place all that we have in His hands. Let us come into the presence of the Lord, for He loves us.

Pray the Rosary daily and attend Mass frequently.
