Why it's important to vote for Pro-Life Candidates

Did you know that residents and business owners of Travis County (Austin Area) will continue to be forced to fund elective abortions with their property taxes. The Travis County Commissioners Court approved the annual budgets that includes a whopping \$450,000 for elective abortions. The commissioners voted September 21, on the annual budget for Central Health (formerly known as the Travis County Healtcare District) that continues to pay for elective abortions (same as prior budget) funded by property taxes. The abortions--as many as 1,000 during the next 12months-- will be performed on demand on healthy women with healthy unborn babies. No medical reason or referral is required. Voting for the abortions were County Judge Sam Biscoe, Precinct 2 Commissioner Sarah Eckhardt, and Precinct 3 Commissioner Karen Huber. Precinct 1 Commissioner Ron Davis abstained, and Precinct Margaret Gomez was absent. Biscoe, Eckhardt, and Gomez were up for re-election in November and were re-elected.
