# Grand Knight's Weekly Reflections

Brothers,

Who was Monsignor Robert M. Nolan, after whom our Council is named? Thanks to Brother Bob Propp, PGK, PFN we have some insights. Brother Bob owns a 'first edition' book, St. Patrick's (The First 100 years) written by Fr. William R. Hoover and published in 1988 at St. Patrick's Cathedral. Its editors are Malinda R. Crumley and Kay Fialho. The following information comes from that book, pages 30-39. St. Patrick's Cathedral was dedicated on July 10, 1892. A 33 year old priest, Fr. Robert M. Nolan, came from Gainsville, TX in 1907 and became its next pastor. In 1908, Fr. Nolan oversaw the building of a new rectory which remains to this day next to the Cathedral. Multiple priests lived in the rectory as well as Fr. Nolan's mother (Mrs. Margaret A. Nolan) and Fr. Nolan's sister, Mrs.May Drake, who was the housekeeper. Fr. Nolan had the Stations of the Cross replaced with the Gothic revival style ones we see there today. He also had installed an organ with 1,268 pipes which provided the growing congregation with beautiful music. Our Lady of Victory school was established in 1909 with the help of Fr. Nolan. It and Laneri High School would later merge to become Robert M. Nolan High School in 1961. In 1913, Fr. Nolan was appointed, what was called at the time, 'dean' of the city which now had 14 parishes and institutions. Dean Nolan would, at times, represent Bishop Joseph Patrick Lynch, who was the Bishop of Dallas. In 1925, Fr. Nolan became Monsignor
