## Message From The Church Director - Ed Leal

Brother Knights in Christ:

In the Gospel this Sunday, Matthew tells us how Jesus urges the disciples of John the Baptist to look for the signs; signs that Jesus is truly the one sent by God. The signs include dramatic transformations in people, physical disabilities healed, Good News proclaimed to the poor. These signs are similar to those prophesied by Isaiah, in the first reading (35:1-6, 10). Such signs would predict the approach of God coming to save the people, to turn their sadness and mourning into joy.

Advent invites us to ask about salvation over and over. We have to ask ourselves today about what signs are given to us. Jesus tells us that only the sign is the Prophet.
