



All Brothers are REQUIRED to enter all Volunteer Hours to include, our meetings, Degree/Exemplification ceremonies participants and sideliners (under miscellaneous), other Volunteer Hours include: Extraordinary Minister, Readers, helpers during Mass etc.. Effective start date for these hours are from September 2018 (council established month) through December 2018. Financial Secretary Ralph and WGK Jeffrey, is required to send ALL of St Anthony Knights volunteer hours, from each category to Supreme in January of each year.
