The Donut Sunday on December 9th was probably the most well attended in the time we have been doing it. Big crowds after both masses. Thanks to all who help with this event.

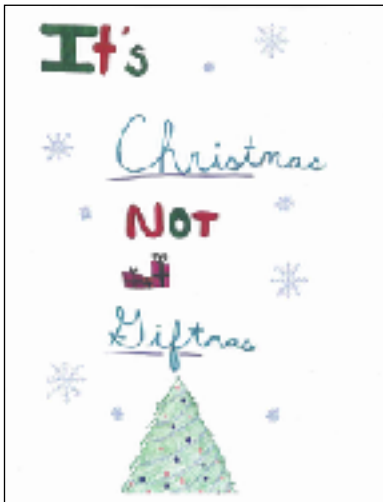
Knights Usher Midnight Mass on Christmas Eve
