

We have a Communion Service twice a week (one at noon Sunday and the other at 7 p.m. on Wednesday night) in which a team member will conduct a liturgical service and distribute Holy Communion at each of these Services. Your service would enable us to rotate our members so that each man would be scheduled to serve every third week. Of course, if these days and/or times do not fit your schedule there are literally dozens of unfilled time/day slots at the jail that are not being filled.
