Work Around our Council Home We have had great weather and got some needed work done at our Council home. Weeds were sprayed, and vines cut off fences. The Sheriff's office team was there on our Spring Work day to help again this year. They raked and collected over 100 bags of leaves and trash around the Grounds of the Hall and all have been finally disposed off a little at a time in the dumpster.

New interior lights were installed, and bathroom doors were repainted, (*a second coat is needed*) continuing the upgrade to the Past Grand Knights bar area. (*The installation of new outside security lights was deferred due to Brother Pressler's medical issues in early May but will be re-scheduled in the future.*)

The slow sink drains, that have been an issue for many months, were taken apart, cleaned out in the kitchen. The dead bushes in the front were removed; new bushes will be planted. A second outside sign was made and installed. The Spring A/C maintenance was also completed; all the units are all in good shape as hot weather is upon us. (*Please remember to turn the temp up if you are the last to leave to save on utilities.*) The fire protection equipment in the kitchen was inspected as well as installation of updated extinguishers where needed was accomplished recently as well.

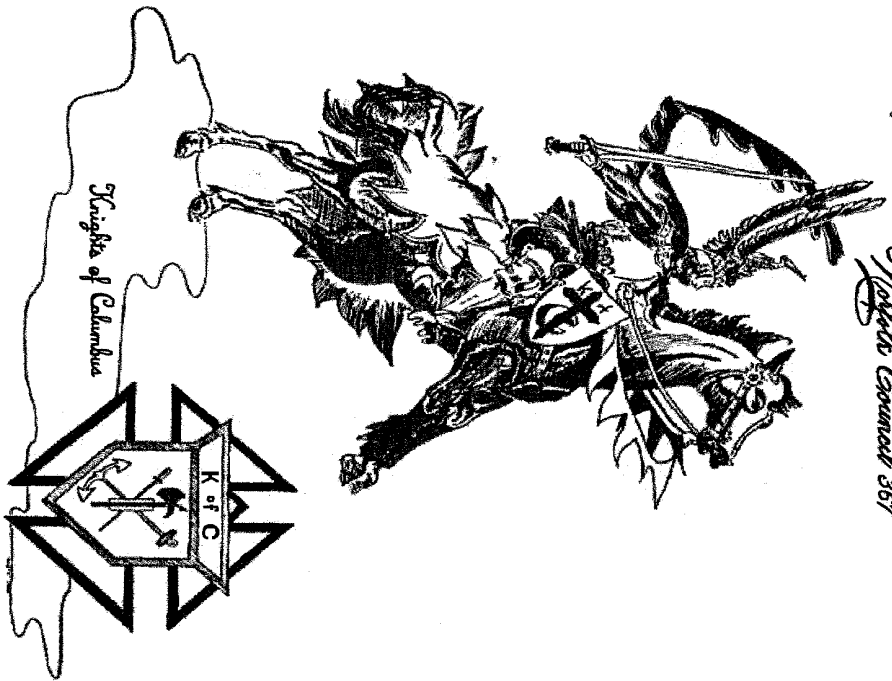
