### Do you Know about our Brother in Need Fund?

A Brothers in Need Fund shall be maintained as a hardship emergency fund for Council members in good standing, to enable the Council to quickly assist with a Brother Knight's temporary need in a financially difficult time. A qualifying hardship shall include the unemployment of a Brother Knight, a medical emergency involving a Brother Knight or immediate family member, or the death of an immediate family member. For these purposes, the "immediate family" of a Brother Knight shall include his wife and dependent children. Any request for moneys from this Fund shall be made by a Brother Knight to the Grand Knight, and decisions to honor or reject any such request shall be made by a majority vote of the Grand Knight, Deputy Grand Knight, and Treasurer. The Deputy Grand Knight and Treasurer will be made aware of the needs of the subject Brother, but will not be made aware of the Brother's name. In order to protect the identity of the subject Brother, moneys from this Fund will be sent directly to such Brother's identified creditor(s), except that moneys provided for food will be in the form of vouchers. Disbursements from this Fund shall not exceed \$2,000 in any fiscal year, and shall be limited to \$500 per Knight during any twelve month period. Funding for the Brothers in Need Fund shall be derived from reserve funds, Council fundraisers, or other contributions; and, shall not be derived from operating funds or budgeted items.
