Hello Brothers here is the information on ordering shirts and hats:

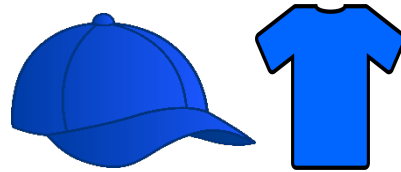
There are two current options available to the members.

Option 1 Process:

1. **The shirt** may be ordered from the catalog Albert Reyes maintains on the day of our council meeting. 2. The order is required to be paid in full, either by cash (exact amount) or by check payable to the Knights of Columbus Council 8306.
3. The order will be placed and the product will be delivered during the next meeting.
4. Should there be issues with the order, the delivery may be delayed until the following meeting.

Option 2 Process:

1. The member will purchase a new product they want to be embroidered from a store of their choice.
2. The member will deliver the product to Create a Stitch. Address: 1613 Fredericksburg Rd. San Antonio TX 78201
3. The cost is \$10 to embroider the Knights of Columbus Council 8306 emblem and their name.
4. The turnaround time should be within a week.



5. The member pays for and picks up the product.
6. Hours of Operation
 - a. Tuesday – Friday 10:00 AM - 6:00 PM
 - b. Saturday - 10:30 AM - 2:30 PM (call to assure their open on Saturday)
