WHEELCHAIRS

Brother Knights loaded 280 wheelchairs at the Bowie Transportation Company, Inc. in Selma, Texas. As shown below, nine of our Brother Knights loaded the wheelchairs onto an 18 wheel trailer and three pickup trucks. Most of the wheelchairs were transported to St. Marks for later disbursement to places in need. Some of the wheelchairs (30) were stored in the house of SK Sam Szalwinski for people on a wait list.

Currently, 210 wheelchairs have been committed for the needy. The commitments include 110 to Christus Santa Rosa Hospital, 26 to CRIT, 10 to the VA Hospital, and 64 to a number of clergy retirement places. The purpose for providing 10 wheelchairs to CRIT is to pay them back for the ones we had borrowed for victims of Hurricane Harvey.
