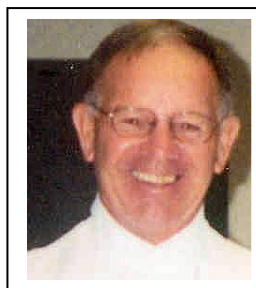

### Basic knowledge on insurance products

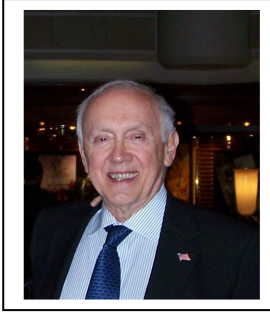


