## Grand Knight's Reflection

With the end of November, we move to the Advent season and the start of a new Church year. But it's the season that is ending that I wish to talk about here - Ordinary Time.

Ordinary Time describes those parts of the Church calendar which are not dedicated to a specific liturgical season, but that name is something of a misnomer. It should not be taken to mean that what happens during this time is any less important. Indeed, we need to take special care to avoid slipping into habit, and not recognizing the wonders of the Mass. I have a story which I always try to remember when I feel in danger of taking Mass for granted.

One time when I was vacationing with my family, we traveled to New Mexico. It was Sunday, and we hadn't had a chance to find many parishes nearby where we could attend Mass, so we went to the nearest one. It was a Spanish-language Mass, a language which none of my family speaks. It was easy to feel isolated there - not knowing anyone in the assembly, and having to read along a translation of the Scripture readings rather than listening to the lectors.

Just before Communion, we went to the Sign of Peace. As I turned around to shake the hands of these strangers, I was greeted with smiling faces and a hearty handshake from all of them. I truly felt welcomed in that church hundreds of miles from home by the love that they showed. It was not just "the part of the Mass where people shake hands." I doubt that any of the people that day still remember me, but I remember them, and I try to show that same love of others at every Mass that I attend.
