The Council Website (<u>www.kofc10947.org</u>) has a very useful Event Calendar that contains information about our upcoming meetings, events, fundraisers and volunteer opportunities?

Click on "Event Calendar" on the home page, and

you'll see the current month (a simple click moves you forward and back a month at a time). Events in **BLUE** are **Council Events**; events in **RED** are **Degree Events**; events in **GREEN** are **State Events**. **Holidays** appear in **LIGHT BLUE**. Council and State events are often "clickable" to reveal additional details and where appropriate, provide an opportunity to sign up as a volunteer or attendee at the event.

Signing up online – to volunteer to help, or simply to attend – is a useful planning tool for those who are organizing the event. We can also track volunteer hours (not on a person by person basis, but on a "total manhours" basis") which is helpful for the reports that your Grand Knight has to file each quarter!

To sign up, simply click on the event, then "click here to sign up". Enter your member number – found on your membership card (non-members can sign up at the bottom of the form) and tell us how many hours you can commit, and if you are bringing any helpers. Click the SIGN UP button, and a new screen will appear where you can confirm your information and make a note as what you can help with, tools you might bring, etc. Then one more click and you're on the roster.

The system will then generate a confirmation email, and the Event Organizer will have a good idea of the support he's getting from his Brother Knights. He'll also be able to communicate with all of the volunteers with just a few clicks of his mouse.



This would include organizations like the Virginia Knights of Columbus Charities Incorporated (VKCCI).

This is an important point to understand as we begin our preparations for our annual Thanksgiving Day Food Drive. We must be clear with people donating to our food and fund drives. We are a 501(c)(8) organization and donations are not tax deductible and we cannot give receipts for donations. Hopefully this information will not deter our patrons from supporting our charitable events.
