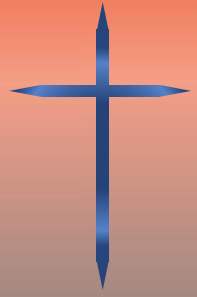

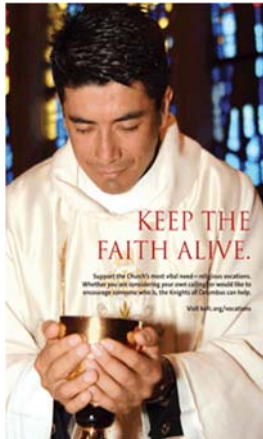

The Christmas Giving Trees will be up in the Narthex beginning November 21st.

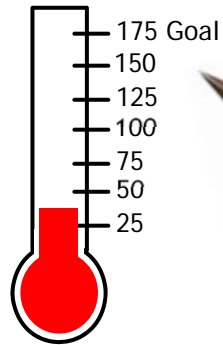
Volunteer sign-up sheets will also be available that weekend ONLY.
