My Brother Knights

Greetings to all my brother Knights and as I write this, I pray that you and yours are doing well and are able to stay healthy in the midst of our pandemic. I truly pray for you all every mass I offer. Just wanted to keep you all up to date on a few things happening here at Saint Helen. As of September 13th, we have been allowed to fill our church to 50% capacity (that is 700 people), it was previously a capacity limit of 25% (that was 350 people). We have had great numbers of people returning to mass (1700 last weekend), though it is not mandated by the Cardinal yet. We therefore have added a fifth mass. So back by popular demand we have an early Sunday morning mass at 7:30 a.m. So, our weekend schedule looks like this;

Saturday...5:00 p.m. Sunday 7:30 a.m./9:00 a.m./10:30 a.m. and Noon (Spanish)

On another most important note:

On November 3, 2020 we will be having Election Day. Many positions held by our politicians will be open for an incumbent or a new person to fill those positions. I cannot urge you strongly enough, as your pastor, your chaplain and your fellow Christian, that these elections are extremely important!!!! We have time, I pray we do....to educate ourselves regarding each candidate running for any office. We must not rely on secondhand information or news media to determine our vote.
