

Tea Time



What makes a good cup of tea?

You won't find your answer at any local restaurant! If you ask for tea, they will bring you a glass of ice tea. Should you ask for hot tea! They will bring you a cup of hot water and a tea bag! Now, if you want a good cup of tea, follow the English ritual of tea making.

For the best flavor choose an earthenware teapot. (or any round shape teapot) Use only fresh water and not previously boiled. Fill your tea kettle with tap water. Bring to a boil; your teapot should be preheated with a bit of boiling water from the kettle, then empty. Next put tea in the teapot and slowly pour the boiling over the tea. Fill the teapot to ¾ full. Allow 1 tea bag per 4 cups of tea. The filled teapot should be allowed to stand for 3 or 4 minutes so that it is properly infused. Individuals tastes differ, some enjoy their tea with milk and sugar, some with just milk or sugar or some like just lemon added. The type of tea is your choice; we prefer Yorkshire Gold.

The best time to enjoy your cup of tea is at breakfast and afternoon. We like ours with all meals. Other than a delicious taste, tea is said to relieve the feeling of fatigue and drowsiness. One more thing, have your tea in a nice bone china teacup and not a thick mug!

P.S. I don't cook, bake or do parties!
