Is KofC Mental Retardation Weekend in the State of Missouri. You might also hear it referred to as Tootsie Roll Weekend, because Knights solicit donation in exchange for a Tootsie Roll candy bar.

Of the money collected, 50% stays in the local community (as a council we will decide what local MR charity to support) with the remaining 50% supporting The Knights of Columbus Developmental Center at Cardinal Glennon Hospital in St. Louis, MO.

We need volunteers to cover our three masses at St. Robert's (Saturday 4pm, and Sunday 9 & 11am.). I only need three volunteers for each Mass. It only takes three volunteers to cover each Mass (two at the main entrance and one at the side door.) So far we have no volunteers for 4pm!

After Communion, you would go to the back of the church where we will have the boxes of candy and the yellow vests. You will put on one of the vests, fill the apron pockets with candy, and stand outside the doors on the sidewalk holding up a Tootsie Roll candy bar.
