September was an active month for the Council. We did some good things, and we're starting to work some of the challenges we face. Our PGK dinner on 17 Sep honored Past Grand Knight Rosario Chechile, and his wife, Gerry. By all accounts, it was a great time. The venue and meals were excellent, the testimonials by Joe Micari, and A.J. Ascone were very witty and well done. Thanks also to those Brothers who contributed by attending and supporting the event. We came together well. Given all the positive feedback, it looks like the picnic will become an annual event.

After the 12:30 Mass on 26 September, some of our Council Members participated in the dedication of the Outdoor Stations of the Cross. These stations were the product of a Boy Scouts of America Eagle Project by

A request:

Brothers, we are a fraternal order of Catholic men – the largest such organization in the World at over 1.8 million members. We focus on and believe in the value of our ideals of Charity, Unity, Fraternity and Patriotism. To give those ideals substance and meaning within our Council requires that we, fellow Knights, engage at some level of participation in the Council's activities. The level of participation we choose is, of course, unique to each of us.

We are a diverse group, and each of us operates in our individual context. For most of us, the critical issue in participation in any activity is the time commitment involved. Today's culture is very demanding in terms of time at work. We naturally reserve a large part of the remaining time for family activities, and for time to unwind with friends. We all dedicate some time each week to Church. We attend Mass, perhaps participate in Church Ministries, and we attend Church functions. Some already commit significant amounts of time to the Knights. Some are, in fact, too heavily committed to provide much, if any, time to the Knights.

I believe, though, that any of us would lend a hand if a small effort, a few hours time, would make the difference between success and failure of one of our Council's activities. In fact, that situation is not all that unusual. On some occasions lately, we have been short handed. However, since most of us are committed to the success of whatever we undertake, a potential failure from lack of resources is frequently offset by participating brothers extending themselves to meet the needs of the activity. That shouldn't happen – not in our

Council.

I've heard on more than one occasion that we need not be concerned about lack of volunteers for a given event. "Someone" always jumps in at the last minute, when needed. I don't believe that. I've seen otherwise, and the downside is that some who would volunteer begin to believe that they are not needed. That is not the case. We have a very talented, very committed group of Knights in our council. I believe that we could carry out virtually any program activity, if we committed to it. What I would like to ask of those of you who haven't volunteered lately is a commitment to volunteer an amount of time appropriate to your situation in at least one Council event between now and the end of June 2011. You will lighten someone's load in that activity. You will make a difference.
