40 Days for Life

In a record number of communities across 50 US states and 23 countries, the largest worldwide pro-life event in history will occur: the UNITED 40 Days for Life campaign, which runs from September 28 to November 6. Since 2007, this ministry has saved close to 12,000 babies and resulted in 75 abortion centers closing, as well as numerous abortion workers quitting the business. On Saturday, September 10th, 130 memorial services will be held as part of the fourth annual National Day of Remembrance for Aborted Children. At many of these sites aborted babies are buried. In Maryland, there will be a memorial service at St. Peter the Apostle Catholic Church in Libertytow, but due to special circumstances, this service will be held on September 17.

The only site in Maryland where aborted children have been buried is at Immaculate Conception Cemetery. Here, 34 late-term aborted babies, discovered in a freezer at abortionist Steven Brigham's clandestine and illegal Elkton abortion facility, were laid to rest.
