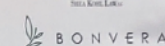
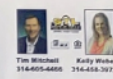
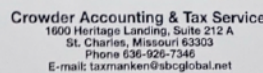

Refreshments were served.

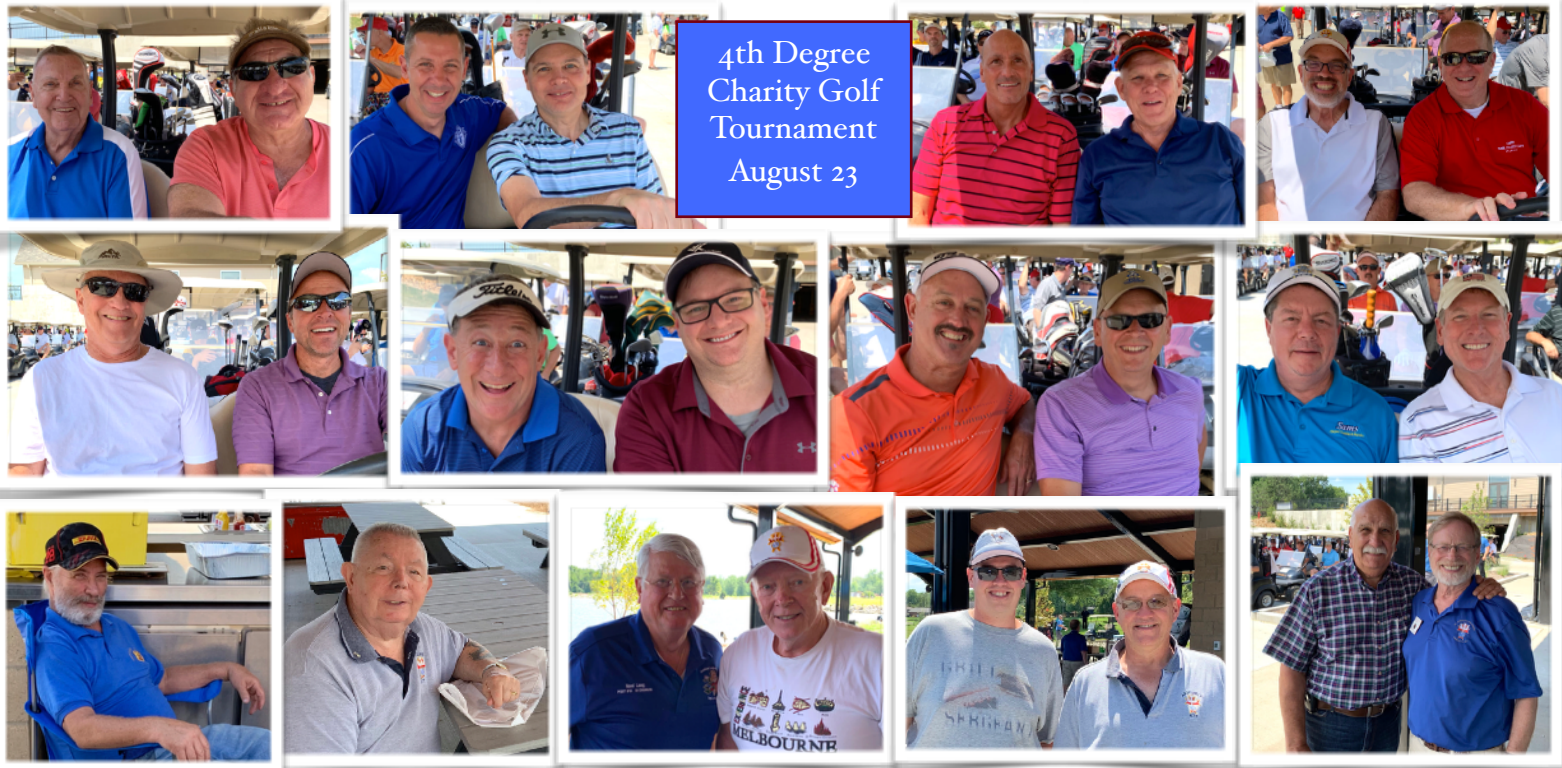
