FELLOWSHIP OF CATHOLIC UNIVERSITY STUDENTS (FOCUS)

During the July 2019 Council 7613 meeting, a presentation was made by Reese Tollette and his sister Reagan (see their picture in the <u>Family of the month of May</u> shown above) pertaining to a Catholic college outreach organization called FOCUS, the <u>Fellowship of Catholic University Students</u>. Both Reese and Reagan have been parishioners at St. Mark's for their entire lives and are currently beginning their first year as full time missionaries for FOCUS.

Reese and Reagan, both missionaries of FOCUS, work to help students on college campuses to overcome difficult times for some who may be experiencing such things as depression, drugs and alcohol, sex, eating disorders, and suicide. The FOCUS program enables college students to go on mission trips, have radical conversions, and to commit their lives to Jesus. Additionally, some go on to share their faith with their friends, start Bible studies and small groups of their own, mentor other students to do the same, and join the community with one another.

In order for Reese and Reagan Tollette to meet their goals this year as FOCUS missionaries at the universities of Maryland (Reese) and Oklahoma State (Reagan), they need an additional funding of \$1200/month - \$400/month for Reagan and \$800/month for Reese
