Grand Knight's Message

Brother Knights,

On your marks, get set, STOP!

Though you might not know it to look at me, I have completed 11 marathons. In the Marine Corps Marathon, participants are asked to wait for the starting gun in the carrel corresponding to the time the runner expects to finish. 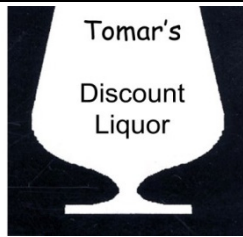

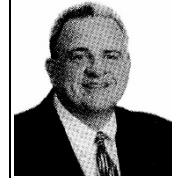

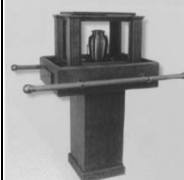
