Thought for September

People sometimes accuse the Church of being a cold collection of rules and regulation. They get no satisfaction from it so they go to some Protestant church. Such churches usually are friendlier. They have to be friendlier because all they have otherwise is sermons and Bible reading.. This friendliness attracts the former Catholic. Why? It's because the former Catholic never knew his faith. It's like he looked at the church building from the outside and saw only dark stained glass windows. If he had come inside the Church he would have seen how beautiful the stained glass windows really were. Or he might be like someone in the dark church at night which seemed gloomy. However, when the lights were turned on he could see the beauty of the building.

It's the same way with our faith, you must get inside it. You must turn on the lights. The only way inside is to learn your faith, to pray and study and go to Communion. Our Church is really a Person...Jesus. You must seek Him. If you make a one dollar effort to seek Him He will generously give you a thousand dollars' worth (so to speak) of grace and peace and strength . But you must seek Him and pay attention to Him. He is true man and true God. As a man He is saddened when you ignore Him. So many people ignore Him yet He loves us all with an awesome Love.

You will have a beautiful close relationship to Jesus when you go to Communion with a loving heart and true belief in His Real presence.
