Council Picnic 9/10/11

"Saturday, September 10, 2011 is our annual family picnic. We can gather anytime after 4:00 pm eat and enjoy each others company until 8:00 pm. The council will provide the hamburgers and hot dogs. Each member and family are responsible for your favorite beverage and a favorite dish or dessert, or both. The rule is bring enough for your family and to share with others. We do not keep leftovers, so please plan to take home what you brought. We appreciate the generosity, but with just two people in the house we wind up throwing food away. We will have paper plates, cups, and plastic ware.

We are on the lake and have a dock, and we have one basic rule - No small children, or non-swimmers are allowed near the lake or on the dock. They have to wear personal floatation life vest or remain up by the house. We do have some life vests, but no guarantee we will have the right size. We would prefer that people do not bring fishing gear at the picnic. The dock is small and if people are swimming it could be a problem. Our address is C-63, and we are off of Gate 2. Gate 2 is off of Colbern Road, 1 mile east of Highway 7. Enter gate 2, drive down about a 1/2 mile, turn left in front of a real estate office, C-63 is a Off-White house on your left as you are facing the lake. If there is no parking at the house you may park in front of the real estate office. See you at the picnic." Henry

Every year in October, the Knights across the State of Missouri band together to raise money for those with Developmental Disabilities, by providing Tootsie Roll candy for donations. The proceeds collected each year are divided 50/50 between the local council deciding what organization should receive their funds (last year we gave our funds to Special Olympics) and the State KofC Council that funds the Knights of Columbus Developmental Center at SSM Cardinal Glennon Children's Medical Center in St. Louis.

The Knights of Columbus Developmental Center provides examinations, assessments and referrals for medical consultation for children with a number of developmental disabilities. The Center was opened in 1981, and is dedicated to treating children with access to a wide range of specialties.

We will need a few hours of your time that weekend as we expand our program to area businesses in addition to collecting after all our Masses.
