INTELLECTUAL DISABILITIES DRIVE (IDD)

The 48th Annual Drive will be held September 21-22-23, 2018. Our council will collect money on Friday Sept 21 from 7am – 5pm and Saturday Sept. 22 from 7am-3pm, at the Posey intersection of highways 127 and 161, Wal-mart (Carlyle), and the IGA (Carlyle). The Intellectual Disabilities or "Tootsie Roll" Fund Drive is one of the most recognizable activities that the Knights of Columbus do. The funds generated from this drive are used to support local programs which help people with special learning needs. Herb Pingsterhaus and Ron Kordick will again co-chair our event. They will be calling volunteers to sign up in September. If you'd like to help and have NOT been contacted by Sept. 15, please call Herb or Ron to get a timeslot.

Rosaries/Funerals/Masses for Members

Note that our council always plans to pray the rosary at 7pm at St. Mary Church on the night before any member's funeral. Then a Certificate of Condolence is presented to the family at the visitation or before or after the funeral. An email is sent to all members (who have email addresses registered) and a small group of members is notified via phone call. If you have not been notified for the recent rosaries and would like to be notified in the future, please provide an email address or notify R. Kordick that you'd like to be called. If you've moved away from the Carlyle area, we may need help to be notified of any members' passing - be sure that your family members know to contact any of our council officers about any status change. Our council also has 2 Masses said at St. Mary Church (or another parish). We have members available to serve the Mass at St. Mary for a funeral. Please advise Fr. George when making arrangements and he will notify us.

Building the Domestic Church

Marriage and the family are at the very heart of society and in recent years have been the subject of many attacks and culturally imposed changes. Aware of the needs of his own time, the Venerable Servant of God Father Michael J. McGivney sought to respond in both a temporal and spiritual way to the crisis in family life affecting Catholics in 19th century America. Thus it has become the legacy of the Knights of Columbus to be a defender and protector of marriage and family life. At the 2014 Supreme Council Convention in Orlando, Supreme introduced a new twelve month family program entitled "Building the Domestic Church – the Family Fully Alive" to help our families become what they are called to be. Through this program, our families can realize more fully their mission to be an authentic domestic church through daily prayer, catechesis and Scripture reading, as well as through monthly charitable and volunteer projects they can do as a family. This initiative can help all families, whatever their difficulties, deepen their relationship with the Lord. It can especially help divorced parents meet their obligation to raise their children in the Catholic faith and reassure them that their communion with the Lord and the Church is not severed, but rather can continue to grow stronger through the means provided by this program. In these ways, they too can be part of our initiative and grow in their faith. Fr.
