RESPECT LIFE~ SEPTEMBER

Welcome back – hope your summer vacation was enjoyable, relaxing,

and rewarding. Now we must get back to everyday business.

One of the question pro-abortionists like to ask is; "What about rape? Don't you think that a woman who was raped should be entitled to have an abortion?" We as Catholics and pro-life supporters should be equipped to answer this. But are we?

We must stress the point that we are concerned with the well-being of the woman, realizing that the woman has undergone a terrible trauma, one we can hardly understand, and her well-being should be our main concern. We must reach out to these women and give them counseling, healing and compassion. The one mistake that is made so often is to talk about the rights of the unborn child.

The woman who has been raped, we agree, has been victimized and needs our help. The question is simply "Will an abortion help her?" Abortion is not the answer to rape; it in no way alleviates the pain

and trauma of the woman. The abortion itself brings a trauma of its own.

Countless women suffer for years and even for decades after they have had abortions. Women who have been raped and have had an abortion are now in counseling not for the rape but for the abortion. In rape, the trauma is "Someone has hurt me." In abortion, the trauma is "I hurt and killed someone else: my child." This, of course, doubles the grief of the whole incident.

Having established that we care about the raped victim, we then can ask the powerful question, why can't we love them both? Why can't we extend to the un-born child the same love and compassion that belongs to the woman? Why should helping and loving one (The Mother) mean destroying the other (The child)? In reality you cannot help one without helping the other and you cannot hurt one without hurting the other.

Please continue to pray for quality of life and respect for all ages. Remember with God all things are possible, without Him nothing will get done.

I offer my congratulations to all the new Knights of Columbus officers and my gratitude to those who served in past years. May God continue to bless all of us.



Council Officers ask that our members remember that our Advertisers have helped to defray the expenses of this newsletter and as a result you should consider using the services of these Advertisers.

We are all aware how rapidly we are moving into the digital age. Even our Supreme Council has come out with the strong suggestion for all of the Councils' Newsletters to be done with Electronic Media; that is, making the newsletters available through the Internet, where they are rapidly available and at the same time with a reduction in materials like paper and ink. This method also eliminates the necessity of postage which is continually increasing with time. Brother Knights and Sister Columbiettes have the option to also print out a personal copy on their printer.

In the coming several weeks a decision will be made to place future Issues on our Website or whether the members will receive a new issue through an email with an attachment containing the electronic form of the newsletter.

To produce the newsletters in electronic form will require the purchase of the necessary software (Adobe Acrobat) and this cost will be covered through the monies available through the Boosters, Advertisers, etc.

In order to not lose any future issues, be sure to contact our Grand Knight, Joe Risi and provide your correct email address! This is crucial; if you do not provide him with this information there is no way we can send the issues to you in electronic form!

For each of us to read these electronic issues (called **pdf** files) you will need to acquire a copy of the **Acrobat Reader at NO COST**.

For those who do not have a copy in their PC, use this link to download this free software and install it into your PC:

http://get.adobe.com/reader/otherversions/

- 1. After this Adobe website opens, you first select the operating system your PC is using; for example, Windows XP SP2 or XP SP3 (if you have kept your Windows software up to date).
- 2. Next you need to select a language; for most of us it will be English.
- 3. Next you'll need to select a Version of the Reader. I suggest Reader X (Version 10.1) since it is the most modern. The most modern versions almost always can read older **pdf** files.
- 4. Then follow the instructions that appear on your screen as you proceed to install this software.


