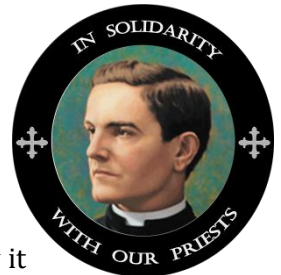

## Chaplain's Corner

This month of September is dedicated to Our Lady of Sorrow, whose memorial falls on September 15. Our Lady of sorrows or Our Lady of Seven sorrows is referred in relation of sorrow in her life. The Seven Sorrows of Mary are a popular Roman Catholic Devotion. There are devotional prayers which consist of meditation on her Seven Sorrows. Examples include the Servite rosary, or the Chaplet of the Seven Sorrows of Our Lady and the Seven Joys of Mary.

It is a common devotion for Catholics to say daily one Our Father and seven Hail Marys for each.

- a. The Prophecy of Simeon. (Luke 2:34-35) or the Circumcision of Christ.
- b. The Flight into Egypt. (Matthew 2:13)
- c. The loss of the child Jesus in the temple. (Luke 2:43-45)
- d. Mary meets Jesus on the way to Calvary.

Let's continue to pray through the intercession of Our Lady of Sorrows that we call to mind the pain endured both by Christ on the Cross and Mary, as she watched her Son be crucified. ## Fraternal Benefits

### Raising awareness about life insurance



Each September since 2003 has been designated as Life Insurance Awareness Month. Like most awareness-raising campaigns, Life Insurance Awareness Month was created because there is an overwhelming lack of understanding of the product among the general public.
