# Pope Francis' Visit to the US

The Holy See press officer explained that on Sunday, morning, September 27, Pope Francis met with the Walkers, a family from Argentina who travelled in a VW camper van to Philadelphia for the World Meeting of Families.

Father Federico Lombardi explained that the Walkers left from Buenos Aires, and covered 11,000 miles and passed through 13 countries during their 194-day trip.

Pope Francis wanted to meet the family because their story profoundly touched him, and he found it an interesting moment.

The parents of the Walker family are Catire and Noelle, and the children are Carlos, Mia, Dimas, and Carmen. They posted on their Facebook page Sept. 27 that "at six in the morning we received a call that the pope wanted to meet us, and that we should immediately go to Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary in Philadelphia."

When they were finally face to face with the Pope, he said, "Are you the family who travelled from Buenos Aires? You're crazy," and he laughed. He then gave everyone a hug and they briefly talked in a family type atmosphere, "as if they were friends forever."

#### **Patriotism**

Patriotism is freedom of worship. (*Knights to Christ* September 5<sup>th</sup> entry)

He said to them, "Go into the whole world and proclaim the gospel to every creature. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved; whoever does not believe will be condemned. (Mark 16:15)

### St. John the Baptist

All four gospels give some details of the life of John the Baptist. He is referenced as a fulfillment of Old Testament prophecies in the Books of Isaiah, Micah and Exodus, about a messenger being sent and a voice crying out in the desert.

The New Testament narratives depict John the Baptist as a powerful and charismatic figure. Even a major political figure of the day, King Herod, enjoyed being near John the Baptist. However, when John criticized Herod's lifestyle, Herod feared John.

John was a major figure not only in Christianity, but also Islam, Mandaeism (in Mesopotamia) and the Baha'l Faith (founded in 19<sup>th</sup> century Persia). The Eastern Orthodox Church celebrates the Conception of St. John the Forerunner on September 23. The icon pictured below is "John the Baptist—Angel of the Desert" from the Tretyakov Gallery in Moscow.

Catholics celebrate the Nativity of John the Baptist on June 24 and the Beheading of John the Baptist on August 29.
