## SILVER ROSE

The Silver Rose event was held at the Day Chapel on Saturday, August 8. Shown below is the Silver Rose as delivered to the chapel. Each year, from early March through mid-December, Silver Roses are stewarded by the Knights of Columbus councils along routes from Canada to Mexico. Every stop the Silver rose makes throughout the pilgrimage is a rosary-centered occasion for Knights, parishioners, and community members to pray for respect for life, for the spiritual renewal of each nation, and for the advancement of the message of Our Lady of Guadalupe,

Our Lady of Guadalupe Silver Rose, shown below, has been a Knights of Columbus tradition for 60 years. In 1960, groups of Columbian Squires in Mexico, Canada, and the United States decided to honor Our Lady of Guadalupe by carrying a rose across North America from Canada to the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Monterrey, Mexico. In 2001 Supreme Knight Carl A. Anderson, at the 119<sup>th</sup> Supreme Council Meeting in Toronto, addressed the effort in culture of life terms, referring to the Our Lady of Guadalupe – One Life, One Rose Program. He urged that it be expanded to every North American jurisdiction.
