Columbian Club President Letter

Brothers,

With summer almost over and football season right around the corner, the club officers have been very busy making improvements and repairs to the council home. With a pretty aggressive agenda moving forward, we have completed a good portion of the list we want to accomplish. To date we have added a beautiful natural stone path through the mulch bed for easier access to and from the public parking area, we used the remaining stone to box out the AC unit in the back for a better look and to help improve the drainage situation from the condensation. Inside the building, with the help of Sgt at Arms Paul Izzo and John Stevenson we have installed a new floor in the hallway to replace the embarrassing, poorly installed low level carpet. The difference is night and day and we hope to replace the rest of the garbage carpet sometime in the future. Unfortunately this was installed less than 3 years ago by one of our members. Lesson learned on vetting contractors we use for our building, member or not. The new flooring was very inexpensive and will make do until we re-do the men's room and fix the crack in the foundation, at which point we will be installing a permanent flooring solution. The BIC, chaired by PGK Lou McGraw is currently working on that and other projects and repairs that are necessary. We have also replaced the juke box speakers both inside and outside due to most of them being blown over the many years we have had them. Security cameras have also been installed in an effort to reduce the theft of food/beer and protect us in case anyone breaks in during off hours.

PGK Lou McGraw has introduced some new snack foods to be made available at the bar at all times; menus can be located on the bar. Lou has also installed new lights around the smoke tent in the back. We are also working on getting the proper approvals for a heater in the smoke tent which will hopefully, depending on the twp., be done before the cold season arrives. PCCP Jim Murphy went above and beyond last year with the Wednesday and Friday lunches which raised a lot of money and helped with the purchase of the new barstools. The additional money left over will be going toward 4 new additional TV's that will be hung from the ceiling inside the bar for easier viewing of the games on Sundays.

VP Mike Bradley has continued his efforts to bring families and the community back into the club. Although every event Mike runs is a success, he hit it out of the park by making the club the official viewing site for the Holbrook Little League during their televised games in the Little League World Series. On Saturday August 12th Mike and his wife Erin had secured tons of food donations from local stores and packed the entire building for what was one of the best events ever run in the building. The atmosphere during the game rivaled any NFL game or Super Bowl in history. The people from Holbrook and the community had a great time and we were able to showoff what we are all about and what we have to offer.

In the near future we are looking to get some plantings along the hill in the back to hide the woods and improve the look around our pavilion, hopefully this fall when the temps are right for planting we will get this done. We will also be looking for volunteers to help with that as well as to clean out the shed and build shelving to maximize our storage space being that we really have none in the building.

On another note, we have gone live with our new website for the Columbian Club Rental Hall. There is a temporary page up for now which just gives rental hall information. In the future we will be expanding the site to include events and specials at the club as well as the info for the rentals of both our banquet hall and our pavilion. As we continue to improve the look and atmosphere at the club, we look forward to seeing you all come down to enjoy it. VP Mike Bradley will be sending weekly email blasts this year highlighting both college and NFL games as well as food and drink specials throughout the football season. This is your council home and we would like everybody to look forward to coming in and enjoying themselves with friends, family and of course, your brother Knights .

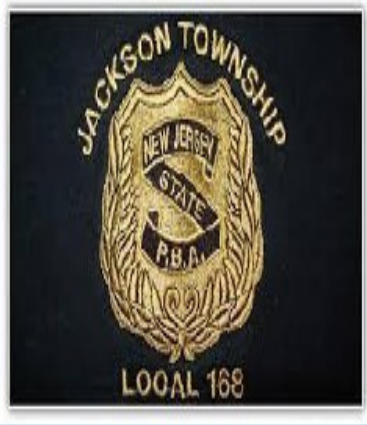

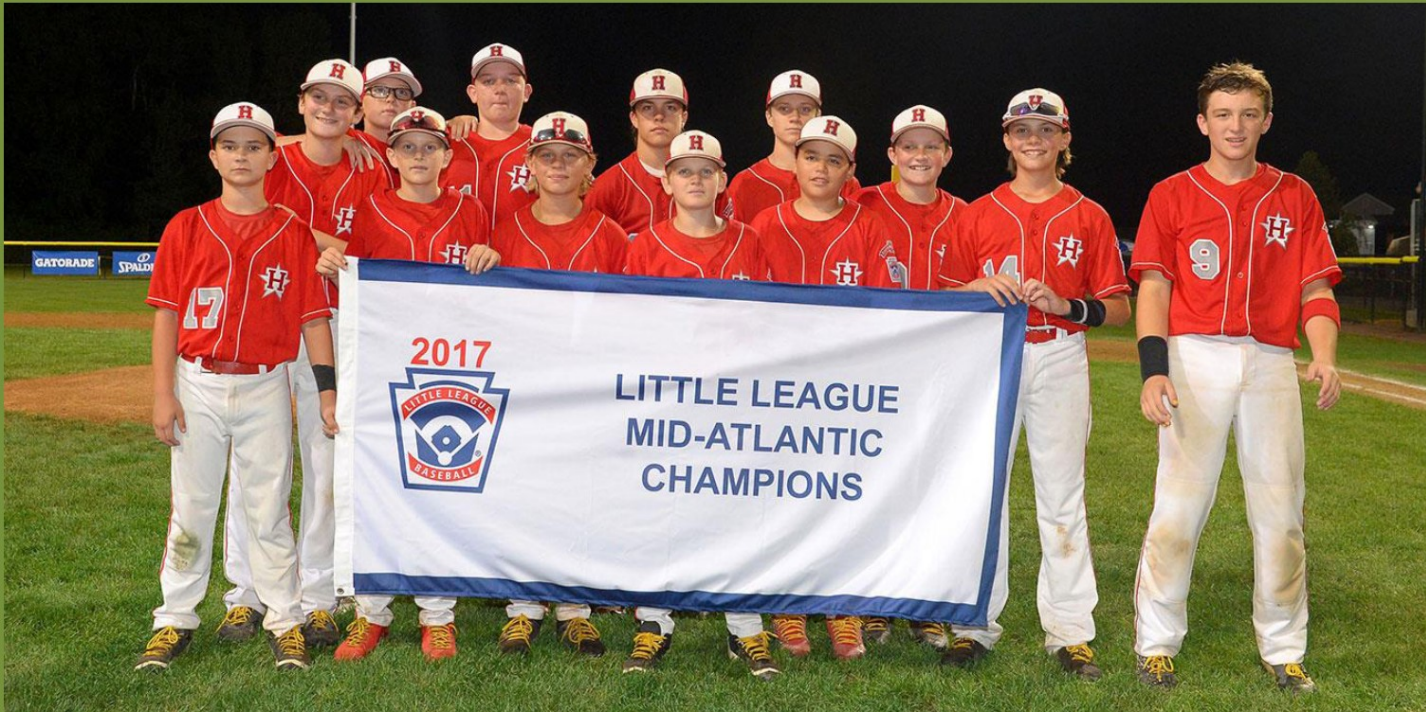
