

Brother Knights:


I hope all is well with everyone and their families. With all of our fundraisers shut down at the present time it's hard to think about charity.

I got an email from Thomas McCaffrey stating that Supreme Knight Carl Anderson announced the "Leave No Neighbor Behind" program which focuses specifically on feeding our neighbors in need. I'm so glad we went ahead with the 40 Cans for 40 Days Campaign. We collected 1501 lbs. of food and also gave a check for 500 dollars to the American Rescue Workers and a check for 500 dollars to St. Vincent DePaul. Rich Moyer and I delivered the goods to Deborah LaValla from America Rescue Workers. She was so thankful for all we gave them. She said they normally service 175 households a month, but with everything going on they are now up to 675 households a month. Thanks to all who helped in this effort.

on so I'll go with something simple. April's council meeting was the first meeting I missed since becoming a Knight.




