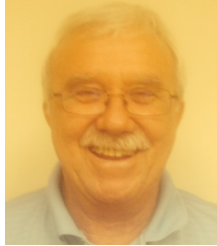

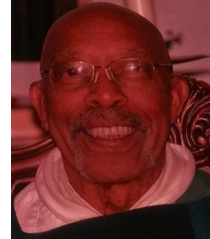

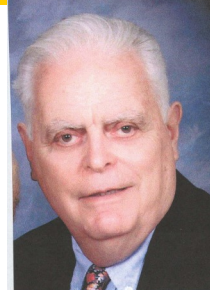

MINUTES OF THE MEETING

Date: September 9, 2014 (7:00 pm) Knight's Hall (Presider: Grand Knight Frank E. Love)

Roll of Officers called.

The minutes preceding meeting were accepted as read.

The Grand Knight read applications for membership approved by the Admissions Committee:

- Transfer for membership: Bob McCausland from Richmond, VA.

Treasurer's Report:

- Council Account: **\$5,135.31**
- Club Account: **\$ 217.33**
- Charity Account: **\$7,323.90**

Grand Knight's Report:

- Building Project—Pat, Roger and Eddy "O" completed the repairs to the hall including the bar and the storage closets. Ronnie Coward submitted a quote of \$225 to replace the rusted pipe at the corner hall.
- We received two agreements from Catholic Radio to review our contract. George Jebaily gave us some pointers. Will be voted on by Council. Gary Towery is raising \$25K to \$30K for equipment.
- This Saturday night (September 13th) at the Knights Hall will be our "Cheeseburgers in Paradise" dinner, started by Doug, sponsored by Marc Weaver and Steve Kubilius. Menu: Hotdogs, cheeseburgers, hamburgers, and mac & cheese. Costs: \$8 per dinner, \$30 per family. Social starts at 6 pm, Open Bar, and Dinner starts at 7 pm.
- We are also holding a Fall BBQ at St. Anthony. We have raised \$1,500 in the past events. Contingent upon approval, the event is planned for October 23rd at St. Anthony's. Motion was made to do the event at St. Anthony's.
- 2nd and 3rd Degree is scheduled for September 23rd. 2nd degree starts at 10 am followed by lunch and 3rd degree will start at 1230 pm.

MINUTES OF THE MEETING (CONT'D)

- Golf tournament at Traces Golf Course on October 18th. Bring a friend. \$50 entry fee per person (includes lunch), or \$200 per team of 4 people, Captain's Choice. Registration starts at 1100 am with lunch and tee time is 1 pm. Maximum of 4 mulligans purchase for \$5 is also available.
- Received two "Thank you" notes from Rev. Fr.'s Karl and Stan for the gift cards.
- We've been asked by Bishop. Past State Deputy, and the current State Deputy to donate at least \$2 per member towards the purchase of an ultrasound machine for Guatemala. The State Council is looking to raise \$15K for the purchase and the Council was asked to contribute \$380 to State Council's Ultrasound Initiatives from the Charity Account and the motion was carried.
- Operation HOPE has already been through 2 weeks of fundraising. We have received funds including private donations in the amount of \$2,500.
- March 14, 2015—projected date. Chip will be holding a Dinner Theater Benefits for the Council. There will be a need of assistance hiring the Production team for the theater number. It will be a mystery theater benefits. Tickets will be \$40, 3 course Italian dinner and a show. Motion made for Chip to organize a committee for the mystery theater and dinner show. Motion carried.

Unfinished Business:

- The Council's updating the membership roster approximately 190 members. Approximately 90 members have not made their email address & phone numbers available and 40 members with delinquent dues. We're asking our members to provide their information for coordination, communication and emergency purposes.

New Business:

- We have a quote of \$225 for Ronnie Coward to repair the Knight's Hall rusted exhaust pipe. Frank will meet with the Board of Trustees for a proposed budget. Motion to hire and pay Climate Technologies costs of \$225 for exhaust pipe repairs. Motion carried.

Under Good of the Order:

- Paul Casillo from Hartsville, former KofC insurance agent is the hospice.
- We pray for the crisis at the Middle East and Africa.

Field Insurance Agent Report (SK Frank Kelley):

- He's asking for a sit down with each member to learn what insurance is available. We are a fraternal benefit society.
- So far, KofC gave \$120M to Catholic related charities.
