Our Council is very pleased to have submitted nine (9) Award Applications to the State Convention to be held at the Toronto International Plaza Hotel on April 22-24, 2016. Included in the Applications is the Trillium Application for a Council in good standing having satisfied all of the fifteen (15) State criteria.

We have also submitted for State Council Service Program Awards our entry in the Burlington COMMUNITY Christmas Parade Float and for our participation in CHURCH breakfasts.

The State Deputy's Council Longevity Community Service Award was applied for our Annual Burlington KofC Golf Tournament.

In the recent past we won the Pope John Paul II Culture of Life Award and have once again submitted for this award, having satisfied all of the eleven (11) activity criteria. (Application requires only five of the criteria to be met !) In fact, our Council did more than this; we also installed "Memorial Stones for the Unborn" at all of our Parishes (including Our Lady of the Most Holy Rosary).

With the help of Br. Ron Milne, we applied for the John P. Rodina Seniors and Widows Program Award on behalf of our Seniors program that gathers every Wednesday morning.

At the express request of GK John D'Addario and DD Steve Reynolds, our Council filed for three (3) Multi Council Awards as follows: Burlington Annual KofC Golf Tournament, Christmas Parade Float and Burlington City Hall Special Olympic Flag Raising.
