**Grand Knight's Message by Bill Lawrence**

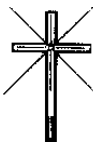
Brother Knights

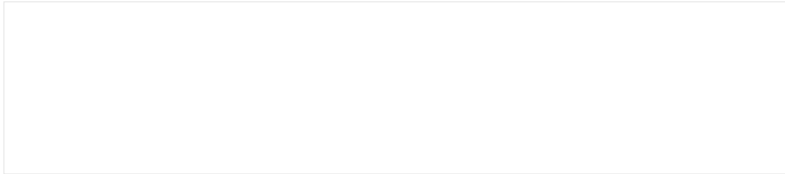
