Again thru the generosity of Bob Evans restaurant we have secured Wednesday, March 15th from 7 AM thru 9 PM for our homeless veterans fund raiser. For every dollar spent for food at Bob Evans on Wednesday March 15th, the restaurant will give back to our Assembly 15% of the entire food bill for our veteran account. Thank you your continued support of this very important ministry.
