Livonia Rosary Rally

(*ANF*) is a nonprofit campaign made up of Catholic citizens united in a common goal: To win the heart and soul of America for Mary, our Blessed Mother. How do we do this? By spreading Our Lady's Fatima message and promoting devotion to Her Immaculate Heart.

To really understand what ANF does and why they do it, you'll find it extremely helpful to first get familiar with the Fatima story. What happened in Fatima, Portugal in 1917 frames the context of everything they do at <u>America Needs Fatima</u>. Last year, ANF sponsored 5,963 Rosary Rallies.

Our Dooley Council will be participating in this year's Livonia Rosary Rally, on October 15, 2011, at Noon, at Madonna University. Brother Ron Danowski initiated these Livonia Rosary Rallies four years ago. Last year's Rally had 94 people attend. We plan on growing the Rally to between 300 to 1,000 people this year. We need *your* help to get the Rosary Rally to reach our attendance goal.

The rallies have the purpose of asking Our Lady for the conversion of America, for the end of sins that offend public morality, and for the Blessed Mother's triumph promised at Fatima. Perhaps even more importantly, the campaign is a public witness of the Fatima message, which is so contrary to the secular view that religion is a purely personal matter for the weak and old-fashioned that must be kept behind church doors.

Fr. Alex Kratz will again lead us in praying the rosary, along with other religious.
